INFORMATION REGARDING EPOGEN[®] (epoetin alfa) REPLACEMENT SHIPMENT

The Safety Net Foundation is pleased to have provided necessary oncology and nephrology products to you and your patients over the years. As you know, the Foundation is a non-profit organization that helps needy patients gain access to such products. We are sending this communication to clarify the EPOGEN[®] replacement process and the availability of the EPOGEN[®] multi-dose vial sizes via The Safety Net Foundation. The Safety Net Foundation provides replacement product for eligible patients in the vial size that was administered by your facility. In addition to the EPOGEN[®] single-dose vial sizes, the following multi-dose vial sizes are available:

- 2mL multi-dose vial: 10,000 Units/mL, NDC 55513-283-10
- 1mL multi-dose vial: 20,000 Units/mL, NDC 55513-478-10

Please remember the following if your facility requests replacement in the **multi-dose vials**:

- If your facility uses the multi-dose vial, all product replacement requests from your facility must be requested in the multi-dose vial size. This ensures accurate balance tracking.
- For the multi-dose vials, product replacement will be shipped once your facility accumulates 200,000 International Units in replacement requests. This requirement is on a per facility basis, not per patient. Therefore, the facility must accumulate 200,000 International Units across all Safety Net patients, not per each patient, prior to shipment being sent.
- If you begin using the multi-dose vial, any previous EPOGEN[®] balance you have with The Safety Net Foundation will be converted to the multi-dose vial size. The Foundation requires two weeks of lead time to convert account balances. Please contact us at least two weeks before you are ready to request multi-dose vials so that we can ensure a smooth transition to the multi-dose vial for your facility.
