Special Storage Requirements

Neulasta® should be refrigerated at 2° to 8°C (36° to 46°F); syringes should be kept in their carton to protect from light until time of use. Shaking should be avoided. Before injection, Neulasta® may be allowed to reach room temperature for a maximum of 48 hours but should be protected from light. Neulasta® left at room temperature for more than 48 hours should be discarded. Freezing should be avoided; however, if accidentally frozen, Neulasta® should be allowed to thaw in the refrigerator before administration. If frozen a second time, Neulasta® should be discarded. **Neulasta® should be inspected visually for particulate matter and discoloration prior to administration. If particulates or discoloration are observed, the product should not be used.** Customers should call 1-800-77-AMGEN (1-800-772-6436) if they have any questions pertaining to proper storage.

Special Shipping Requirements

Neulasta® is a stable drug, but care should be taken to ensure that temperature control at 2° to 8°C (36° to 46°F) is maintained in transport and storage of the product. **When shipping Neulasta®, a foam or gel refrigerant ice that has been frozen hard at -18°C (0°F) for a minimum of 24 hours should be used. Neulasta® should never be exposed to dry ice.** Amgen will ship Neulasta® in a manner that maintains its temperature to meet the requirements stated above during transport from Amgen to wholesaler. Wholesaler should also package and ship Neulasta® in a manner that maintains this same environment. Customers should call 1-800-77-AMGEN (1-800-772-6436) if they have any questions pertaining to proper shipping.
